For example, a Bachelor of Science in Health Arts is a completion program mostly for dental hygienists, radiologic technologists, registered nurses, respiratory therapists, or other health care professionals who are looking to add a liberal arts education to their previous health science background. It would not be a typical path to follow if you wanted to go into emergency medicine, for example. Some options offered are specifically for health professionals looking to move into leadership or managerial positions. These would not be undergraduate programs and are not typically chosen by those looking to enter the medical field. By the same token, if you are looking to become a medical doctor, a program offering a PhD is probably not the direction you should take.

You can achieve all manner of medical degrees online now, ranging from a Bachelor to a Doctorate. The choice is yours. Through research, you'll find several colleges offering their services for a wide variety of medical programs to follow.
