The heads are mounted open mouth and the teeth are highly shown, the tongue is true to life inserted. The eyes are state of art implant quality. They make the bear skin rugs look alive, the manufacturer must allow long time and care to the eyes, mouth and ears. The highest quality bear furs come from the virgin wilds of the North. Some are 6 ft in length.

The grizzly bear rugs are larger than the black bear rugs. They can have black or cinnamon shade; sometimes you can find a rare blond grizzly bear skin rug. From Canada can come even the rare white color bear skin rug; but its price is really high.

The Grizzly bear is also known as brown bear and sun bear, this large predator distinguished from the black bear by a distinctive hump on the shoulders, a dished profile to the face, and big claws about the size of a human finger. The fur of a grizzly bear rug is usually darkish brown but in rare cases can vary from very light cream to black. The long hairs on their shoulders and back often have white tips and give the bears a "grizzled" appearance, hence the name "grizzly." Grizzly bears are in high demand but very rare compared to black bears. A grizzly rug price is 3-4 times as much as a black bear rug.

There are hunters or designers who really appreciate and need this kind of bear skin rugs. These rugs are realistic and their quality isn't sacrificed for the price.

Any quality bear skin rug will look great in front of the fireplace or mounted on a wall, but it can be used as a great area rug too.
