

## Gifts Ideas For Baby Showers

She knows she will need an endless supply of diapers as children use them up extremely quickly. Even if you are giving another gift, a pack of diapers will also come handy as a second-line gift.

**Baby toys:** probably the most common baby shower gift! What's more, you can't really go wrong with it. Remember though that newborn babies are able to use only the simplest toys such as soft toys, baby rattles etc. Anything more fancy or complicated is better for toddlers and sometimes completely unusable. So, if you're buying toys, go for those simple, colorful and non-toxic (the toys will be bitten and possibly even swallowed!).

**Gift certificates:** while they are great gifts to give, since they let parents buy things for themselves, but it leaves a feeling of being too easy. The gift-giving is as much about giving useful things as for showing how much we care for others.
