Before the show begins, various audience members who were not selected to participate are invited on-stage to face easier challenges, such as eating assorted types of insect. The winner of this competition wins fantastic prizes, like a yearly pass to the park. This is followed by an audience warm up with the hosts of the show.

The show consists of half a dozen contestants that were chosen right out of the casting office! If your very lucky, you may be one of these! They are clothed just as the contestants on the original F. Factor clothed in tight uniforms. A sequence of challenges, much like the challenges on F. Factor are presented to the contestants.
