

The Purchase Of Diamonds Online

Do a research for buyer reviews, on the business, on the Internet. It's a good idea to check the Better Business Bureau Online to see if there are, or have been, any complaints.

Ask for a diamond grading statement from an autonomous laboratory such as GIA, HRD, EGL or AGS. You most certainly should see the report prior to buying a Diamond. Lastly, use a respected escrow service for top-dollar diamonds preferably one which will value the diamond while it is in their keeping. The dealer sends the diamond to the escrow service, and you make available the fee, to pay for the diamond, to the escrow service. The escrow service has the diamond appraised, sends the diamond to you, and sends the fee to the dealer.

Quite simply this is the surest way to defend yourself! Ensure you use a respectable escrow service! They will provide accurate details of 'your stone' and its value. This will provide confirmation of your own researches.
