

Complete List of Nintendo Wii Games Revealed

For avid followers of the latest video games, Nintendo has developed the Wii system, formerly codenamed "Revolution". The most notable inclusion in the bundle package is the remote, which according to Nintendo can manipulate actions in the game Legend of Zelda: Twilight Princess.

Launched on November 14, 2006, Nintendo promises a different gaming experience that will thrill not only video game aficionados but also people who used to think video games are children's toys.

Nintendo confirmed that 21 game titles will make it during the launching date, and are available for release in North and South America, while the next 12 games are to be released in the 2006 launch window.

The complete list of Nintendo wii games released during the console launching are: Avatar: The Last Airbender, Call of Duty 3, Crayon Shin-chan Saikyuu: Kazoku Kasuka Peking Wii, Elebits, Excite Truck, The Grim Adventures of Billy and Mandy, GT Pro Series, Kororinpa, Machi Kuru Domino, Marvel: Ultimate Alliance, Necro-Nesia, Barnyard, Cars, Dragon Ball Z: Budokai Tenkaichi 2, Ennichi no Tatsujin, Far Cry: Vengeance, Gottlieb Pinball Classics, Happy feet, The Legend of Zelda: Twilight Princess, Madden NFL 07, Monster 4x4 World Circuit, Need for Speed: Carbon, Open Season, Rampage: Total Destruction, Rayman Raving Rabbids, Red Steel, SD Gundam G. Breaker, SpongeBob SquarePants: Creature from the Krusty Krab, Super Fruit Fall, Super Monkey Ball: Banana Blitz, Super Swing Golf, Tamagotchi's Sparkling President, Tom Clancy's Splinter Cell: Double Agent, Tony Hawk's Downhill Jam, Trauma Center: Second Opiniion, WarioWare: Smooth Moves, Wii Play, Wii Sports, and Wing Island.

These are the complete list of Nintendo wii games so far but reports from Nintendo said other games for the Nintendo wii system are being developed in addition to the complete list of Nintendo wii games. Some, among the complete list of Nintendo wii games, are not available in Japan like the Wii Sports.

The console of the Nintendo wii system features an Optical Media Drive that takes in 12cm wii game discs as well as 8cm Nintendo GameCube discs. The optical media drive lights up for a moment after turning the console on and flashes when reading new data.

The remote, on the other hand, is a controller that uses accelerometers while an infrared detection using several LEDs inside the Sensor Bar enables it to identify its position in a 3-dimensional space. Also included in the bundle package are many more features. You can catch the complete list of Nintendo wii games and you decide whether it's an addition or a distraction to the existing video games.
