

Loreal Microdermabrasion Home System

At present, there are many microdermabrasion home system kits available and one may be spoilt for choice. Essentially they all aim to provide the same sort of results and user friendliness; in most cases customers choose a brand which has got a well known reputation.

Since the microdermabrasion homes system craze kicked off recently, leading cosmetic company, Loreal, have come out with their own microdermabrasion home system.

The general consensus with regard to the Loreal microdermabrasion home system kits are that, significant complexion improvements are seen within the first few days of usage (i.e. smoother and healthier looking skin), tone and skin clarity are greatly improved and uneven skin colour is evened out in areas where tanned or scarred skin are present.

The Loreal system contains a gentle micro-dermabrasion exfoliator and a post treatment SPF 15 sunscreen moisturiser. The beauty of this system, unlike many others, is that the whole process can be done in about 20 minutes after taking a shower in the morning. It is quick and easy to use and the instructions that come with the kit are very straight forward and simple to follow.

The Loreal system works in two steps.

Step 1: Simply, just massage the exfoliating micro-crystal cream into the target areas. After the massaging phase, the area is rinsed then pat dry.

Step 2: Hydrate the fresh skin surface with the therapeutic nutrient rich post-treatment moisturiser.

Most people are satisfied with the results that this product yields and most reviews have said that the Loreal microdermabrasion home system yields immediate visible results. Consumers report healthier revitalised glowing skin; desired skin tone can be achieved very quickly with system.

Although the results appear quickly, they also disappear quite quickly so the process has to be carried out at least once to twice a month. The treatment has also been reported to cause stinging and irritation with some reports stating that within the first few days of usage, whitehead breakouts and skin flaking.

In summary this system may be a good choice for home microdermabrasion but it would help if more published literature reviews were made available to members of the public so that a general consensus about the product can be made. When questioning professionals, (i.e. dermatologists, beauticians etc.) the Loreal microdermabrasion home kit falls under their top 3 choices of microdermabrasion home systems thus implying that this, in itself, would be a good demonstrator of its efficacy as well as its reputation.
