Often a burglary will occur because the house does not have an alarm and is the easier target. Yes, even if it is a small home or not in a wealthy community, your home is a target for a robbery.

Another common misconception is that a burglar will not stop if there is an alarm. But as homes with alarm systems are more difficult to break into, most burglars try and avoid them. Most burglars pick out the first house that appears to have easier access, since the majority of the burglars are not professionals but opportunists. If there is an easier house to break into elsewhere, they will quickly bypass the house with the alarm system.

Though some people think that, by cutting wires, a burglar can easily disarm an alarm system, that scenario doesn't come into play with a wireless burglar alarm. Likewise, there are others who feel that, rather than being a deterrent, installing a wireless burglar alarm will instead make their property seem more valuable, more in need of protecting, and thereby more attractive to burglars. Once again, a thief is not very confident and will choose the less challenging house to break into.

The burglar alarm increases safety. Since even average homes have TVs, appliances, movies, games, cable boxes, and other belongings regularly sought after by burglars, having a burglar alarm does not indicate that you have valuable property.
